

Quebec Visas

Student must acquire a CAQ (Certificate of Acceptance by Quebec) prior to applying for student permit in Canada. Required forms for CAQ:

- Completed CAQ application
- Letter of acceptance by a Quebec school
- A notarized guardianship letter provided either by school board or by Red Leaf representative.
- Letter from parents giving permission for their child to study in Quebec and proof of ability to provide financial support – signed by both parents
- Proof of income in the form of current bank statements or original certificates of deposit
- A notarized parental declaration, signed by both parents, which names the person in Quebec (legal guardian) to be legally responsible for the student. This information can be obtained from the guardianship letter provided by the school board or Red Leaf representative
- Two recent photos of the student
- Student Birth Certificate indicating parents' names – original or notarized copy
- Notarized photocopy of a valid student's passport
- Copies of both parents IDs or passports.

Once the CAQ and student visa have been obtained and the student arrives in Canada, the STUDENT MUST BRING THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS TO THE SCHOOL IN MONTREAL in order to obtain a temporary eligibility certificate to go to English school in Quebec:

1. CAQ Certificate
2. Original birth certificate with both parents names on it
3. Passport
4. Immigration papers.
